


1. What is your age?


2. Would you be interested in a group ride? If so, when? Check all that apply.


3. How would you assess your ability?


4. What kind of trails do you like to ride? Check all that apply.


5. In the MWV, what is your favorite trail system to ride?










10. How can White Mountain NEMBA better serve its members and MB riders in the MW Valley? Check all that apply.
